AH BOY, YOU HAVE STARTED TO ASK THE RIGHT QUESTIONS, LET ME TELL YOU A STORY.

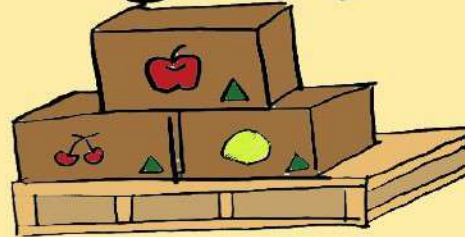


GRANDPA, WHY IS IT IMPORTANT TO GROW OUR OWN FOOD?

OH, THAT IS WHEN WE TAKE UP SOME LAND AND USE IT UP FOR SOMETHING ELSE.

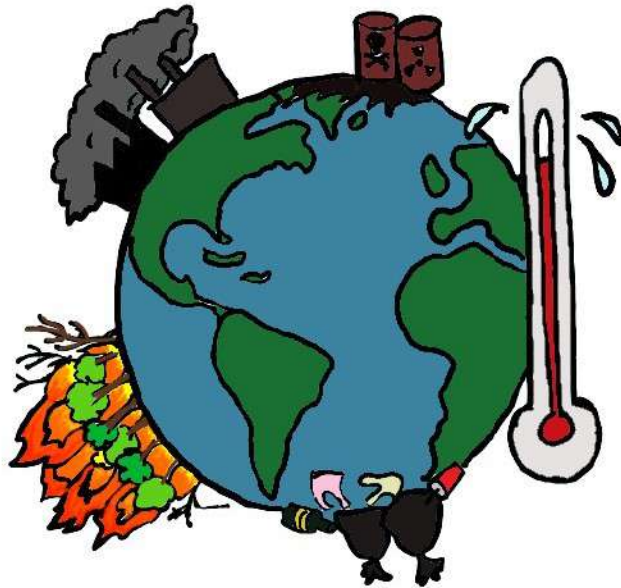




SO, ISN'T THAT GOOD?

DROPPED.



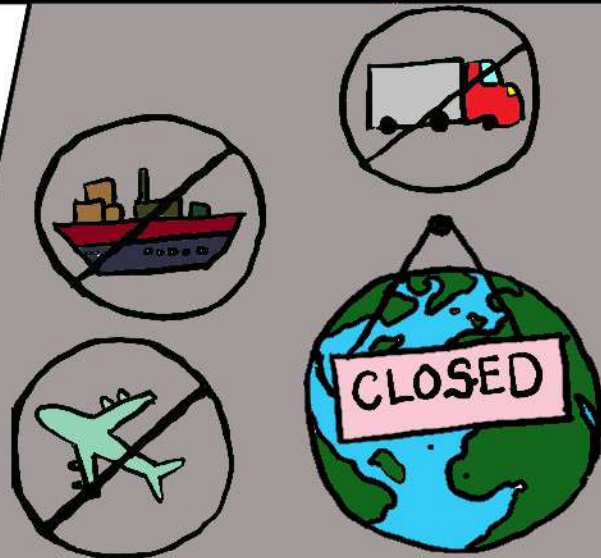
AND THEN CAME 2020. IT WAS SUPPOSED TO BE THE BEST YEAR. GREAT PEOPLE

VISION 2020.





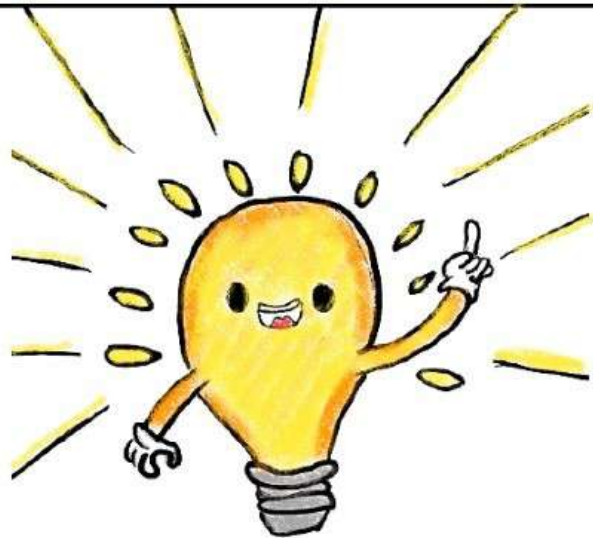

GLOSSARY

URBANIZATION

The process by which large numbers of people become permanently concentrated in relatively small areas, forming cities

LAND RECLAMATION

Process of creating new land from oceans, seas, riverbeds or lake beds making them more suitable for a more intensive use

DEFORESTATION

Clearing or thinning of large area of forests by humans for other uses

AGRICULTURE

The science, art or practice of cultivating the soil, producing crops, and raising livestock with varying degrees in the preparation and marketing of the resulting products

TRADE RELATIONS

A system of trading between two countries in which each country attempts to balance its trade with that of the other

VISION 2020

A long-term development plan of Malaysia to achieve the status of a self-sufficient, industrialized nation by the year 2020, encompasses all aspects of life including economic prosperity, social well-being, education, political stability, and psychological balance

COVID-19

Disease caused by a new strain of coronavirus discovered in the year 2019

PANDEMIC

An outbreak of a disease that occurs over a wide geographic area and affects an exceptionally high proportion of the population

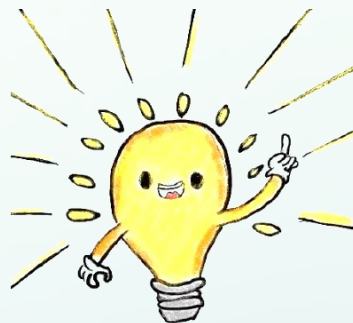
FOOD SECURITY
